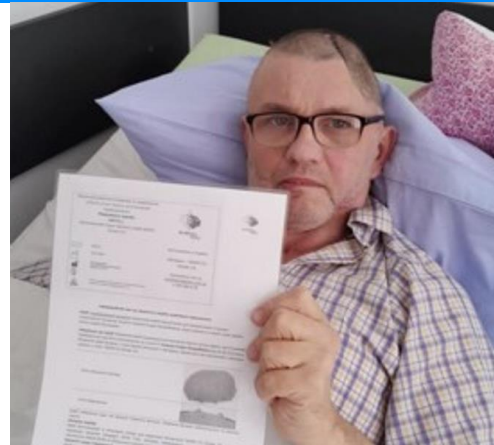
In 2024 we managed to expand our initiatives with two important and complex areas:



Face & Head Reconstructive Surgeries

Addressing a growing unmet need, we stepped in a domain of providing patients with severe head and face trauma with individually printed metal implantable plates to support reconstructive surgeries around Ukraine by experienced surgeons.

We teamed up with Viterra and The Sails of Freedom Foundation (NL) to source, refurbish and supply specialised neonatal ambulances to the areas where they were most needed.

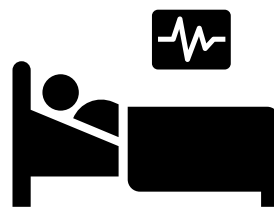


In 2024 we have been focusing on supporting:

- power infrastructure, trauma treatment capacity and transportation means of overall **25 public hospitals** in **16 regions** of Ukraine
- **42** individual **patients** requiring face or head reconstructive surgery
- numerous **military doctors** / medical units involved in medical evacuation of civilians and soldiers

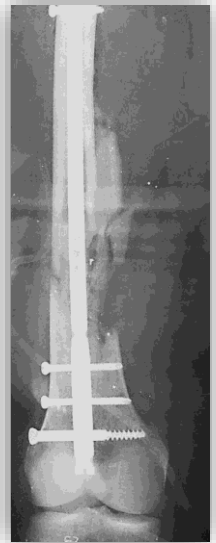

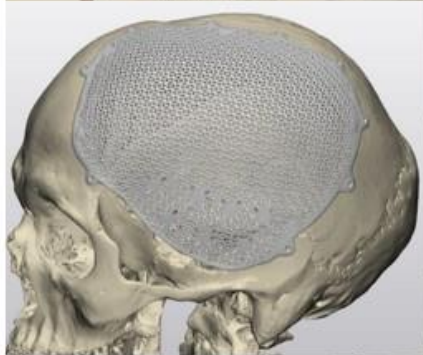
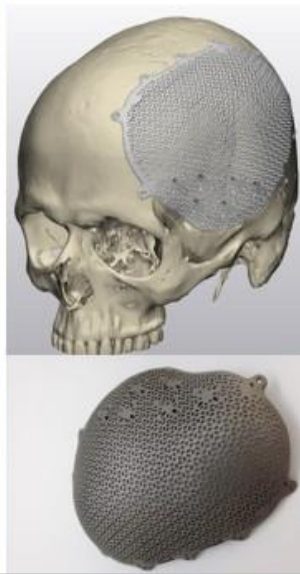




Face & Head Reconstruction

42 patients (incl. **36** in 2024) underwent reconstruction surgeries with individual 3D printed implants

USD 71,637 donated by the Pfizer Foundation and Citi Ukraine transformed into **42 individual implants** (~USD 1,706 per 1 surgery)



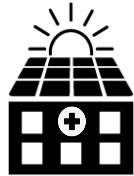
During 2024 we worked on installation of **9 solar power stations** for 9 public hospitals in 7 regions in collaboration with local communities:

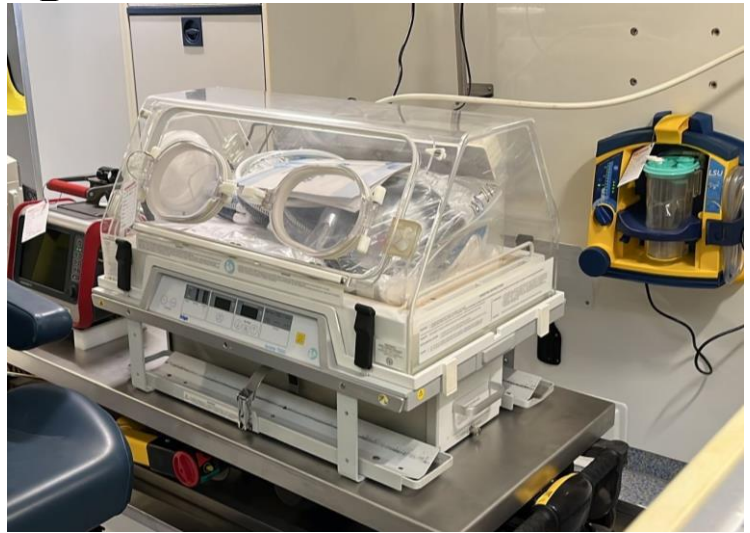

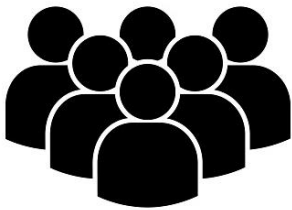
